## INTERFACE VALIDATION CHECKLIST



The interface specification document should describe a solution to be developed. To ensure the proposed solution meets stakeholder requirements and fits business goals, use the following checklist:

All main and alternate flows are covered

Correct terminology is used

Correct data types, formats, default values, and validation rules are used

Error handling is included in the design

Localization requirements are met

Specific usability requirements are met

Information security requirements are met and data access is granted according to user roles and privileges

Quality attributes for the interface (such as availability, reliability, and performance) are considered

Design standards and guidelines provide principles and best practices for creating a consistent solution

Design standards and guidelines are properly applied
